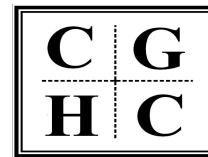


Classification framework for departmental archives

An archives department's classification framework is a general plan for the distribution of documents held within the department, a description and classification tool that organizes archival collections into documentary series and sub-series based on their provenance, date, and type. This framework is common to all departmental archives departments.
